

The National Disability Strategy 2010-2020 is Australia's framework for creating a more inclusive society that enables people with disability to fulfil their potential as equal citizens.

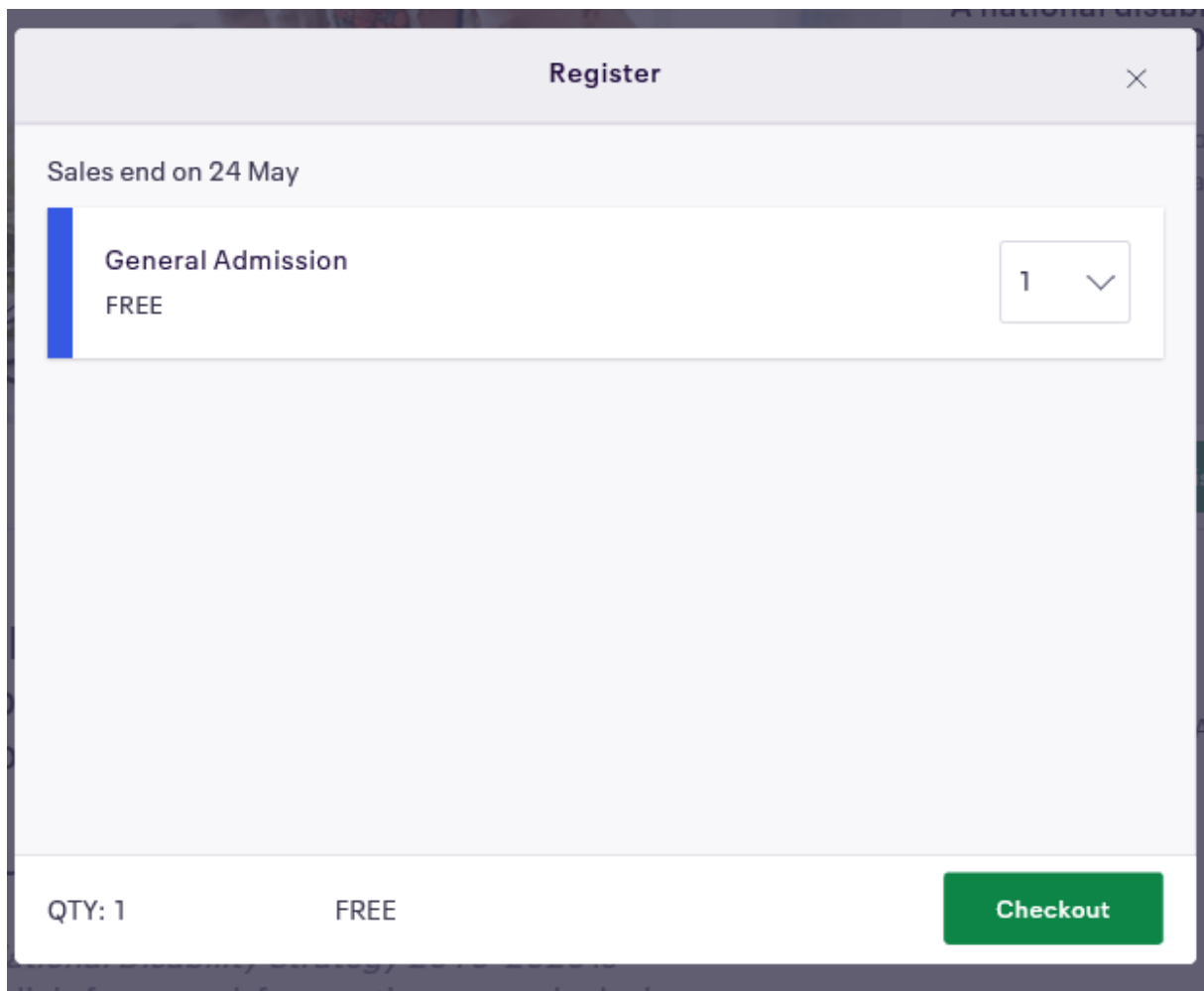
