In the Nursery setting infants that are six weeks to fifteen months given their needs at a young age, I strongly believe that to be able to support the more needy infants the child ratio of one educator to three infants would be more appropriate than the current ratio of one to four.

I strongly feel that while the current ratio seems reasonable and is appropriate when all infants are settled but this is not always the case and I feel that the neediness of multiple infants in the nursery setting should be a consideration!
