1.1 What would a partnership between CSOs and the government that achieves outcomes for Australians being supported by the community sector look like?

This aspect emphasizes the importance of collaboration and cooperation between the government and the community sector. It's crucial for ensuring that the sector's expertise and perspectives are valued and integrated into policy and decision-making.

All NFP organizations are required to submit their annual reports to the ACNC. If more details are included in this annual report, then that report should form part of the basis of any grant application. It would be easy and practical to link ACNC reporting to Grant applications in my opinion.

1.3 How can government ensure the community sector, including service users, and those not able to access services, have an opportunity to contribute to program design without imposing significant burdens?

Maybe the implementation of certain guidelines and criteria be provided by the government to those applying for grants depending on the type of activity being planned. If the criteria are not met then the grant is not approved, for example, for any outdoor activity are there suitable facilities that are easily accessible to those that require easy access e.g., toilet facilities for persons with a disability.

2.1 What would adequate and flexible funding look like?

Ensuring that grant funding covers the true cost of delivering services is essential for the sustainability and effectiveness of community organizations. Underfunded programs can struggle to provide high-quality services, so addressing this issue is a step in the right direction.
