2.2 What administrative and overhead costs are not being considered in current grant funding?

Organisation:

It should be allowed for non-profit organisations to include (at least once) the cost of on the grant :

1) Insurance/public liability (up to \$20M) to hire venue

2) Website and maintenance - it's good to keep their good work record

5) Accountant/auditor - if required for the grant receiver
