- some people with disability are in the **NDIS**



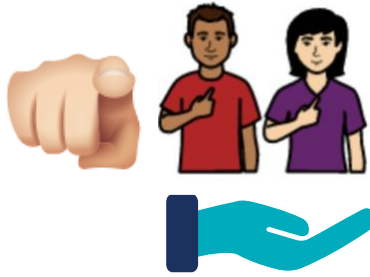
- lots of people with disability are not in the NDIS
