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The Disability Royal Commission



The Disability Royal Commission looked at how people with disability are treated.

We call it the Royal Commission.

It happened between 2019 and 2023.

The Royal Commission listened to lots of people with disability.



The Royal Commission shared many recommendations.

Recommendations are ideas to do things better.

First Nations Disability Forum



The Royal Commission made a recommendation to have a First Nations Disability **Forum**.

We call it a **Forum**.



A Forum is a group of people who

- Talk about what First Nations people with disability need
- Come up with ideas to make things better.



The Royal Commission recommendation said a Forum should include

- First Nations people with disability
- Organisations that support First Nations people with disability
- Organisations that speak up for First Nations people with disability.



The Royal Commission recommendation said a Forum and governments need to **work together.**

This means the

- Australian government
- State and territory governments.

This is very important when governments are making decisions about First Nations people with disability.

A Forum could support

 First Nations people with disability to share their stories and ideas



 Governments and First Nations people to work together



 Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisations.

We call them ACCOs for short.

ACCOs are organisations

- Run by First Nations people
- Who support First Nations people in their community.

2 Who should be part of a Forum



A Forum could include First Nations people with disability who are

From organisations that support First
 Nations people with disability

 From organisations that speak up for First Nations people with disability like
 First Peoples Disability Network



• Not part of an organisation.

The Forum could include people who work for the



- Australian government
- State and territory governments.

There are different ways we could run a Forum.



We could have

- 1 Forum for all of Australia
- Forums in each state and territory.



A Forum could have First Nations people with disability from different parts of Australia like

Cities



• Remote places.

3 Who should a Forum make recommendations to



A Forum could

- Talk about problems
- Share recommendations.



The recommendations would be about what needs to change in

- Governments
- Services that support First Nations people with disability.



The Forum could share their recommendations with the **Joint Council on Closing the Gap**.

The Joint Council is a group that want to improve life for First Nations peoples.

The Joint Council is made up of



- First Nations leaders
- Government Ministers.

Ministers are leaders in an area of the government.



The Forum could share their recommendations with Disability Ministers in each state and territory.

4 What could be funded

The Forum will need support to work well.



Funding could support the Forum.

Funding is **money from the government.**



Funding could support people at the Forum to

- Be paid for their time and travel
- Visit and talk to First Nations people with disability around Australia
- Make ACCOs stronger.
- Increase jobs.


A **secretariat** could support the Forum.

A secretariat is a group of people who can




- Organise meetings
- Make appointments
- Write down the recommendations.











5 How would a Forum work with other groups



The Forum would be a new way for the government and First Nations people with disability to work together.

The government will still work with other groups that look at

- Early childhood
- Health
- Housing
- Justice
- NDIS.



The Forum would **also** work with these other groups.

6 How should the government check if a Forum is working well



There could be a plan to check the Forum is working well.

We could

- Work out the things to do first
- Plan to check how the Forum is working after 1 year.
- Plan an evaluation.



An evaluation means looking at what

- Worked
- Did **not** work.
