# **About the NDIS Reform Advisory Committee**



The government did a **review** of the NDIS.

A review is when you check what

- Works
- Needs to change.

We call it the NDIS Review.



The NDIS Review wrote a report.

They put lots of ideas about how to make the NDIS better in the report.



In May 2024 the government said they wanted to set up a committee.

The committee is called **NDIS Reform Advisory Committee**.

We call it the NDIS RAC for short.



The NDIS RAC will help with changes to the NDIS from the NDIS Review.

#### They might

- Give advice
- Make sure the changes to the NDIS are done well.



We are looking for people to join the NDIS RAC.

#### They might be

- People with disability
- People with experience with disability.



Anyone who wants to join the NDIS RAC needs to put in an **Expression of Interest**.

We call it an **EOI** for short.



An EOI is an application form that says you want to join something.



You can decide if you want to join the RAC.



If you do want to join the NDIS RAC you can fill out this application form.

#### • Working groups

Working groups are a group of people working together on a topic.

You do **not** have to say yes to being on a working group.



#### Roundtables

Roundtables are meetings that people come to talk about a topic.



#### • Focus groups.

Focus groups are when people give their ideas about a topic.



People will be chosen to be on the NDIS RAC by the **Minister** for the NDIS.

Ministers are leaders in an area of the government.
