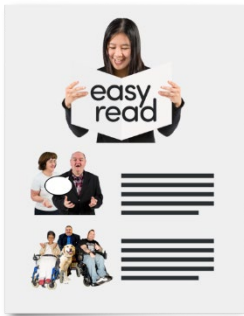

# About the NDIS Evidence Advisory Committee



The Australian Government is setting up the **NDIS Evidence Advisory Committee**.

An Advisory Committee is a group of people who



- Go to meetings
- Help make decisions
- Come from different areas.

We call it **EAC** for short.



EAC will start from July 2025.



They will have meetings during the year.



The EAC will check that NDIS supports are

- Good
- Safe
- A good use of money.

The EAC will also check NDIS supports help people with disability.



You might pay for these with your NDIS **funding**.

Funding is **money from the government** to take part in the NDIS.



EAC will look at what NDIS supports work well for people with disability

They will help with ideas about

- **Capacity building**



Capacity building is teaching you new skills to help you do more for yourself.



- **Assistive technology**

Assistive technology can be things to help you

- Speak
- Move
- See
- Hear.

- Why you would be good on the committee.

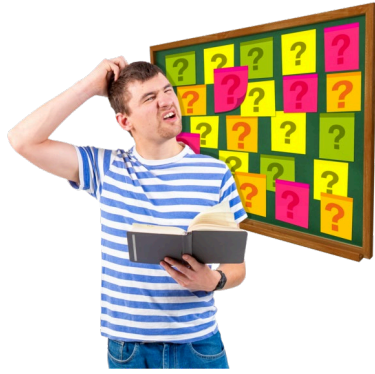


We want people with different experiences on the EAC.
